QUALIFICATIONS FOR OFFICE

A person is qualified to be nominated, elected, and to hold office as a member of the Town of Comox Council if they meet the following criteria:

- Canadian citizen;
- 18 years of age or older on general voting day on October 15, 2022;
- resident of British Columbia for at least 6 months immediately before the day nomination papers are filed; and
- not disqualified under the *Local Government Act* or any other enactment from being nominated for, being elected to or holding the office, or be otherwise disqualified by law.

CAMPAIGN PERIOD EXPENSE LIMITS

In accordance with the *Local Elections Campaign Financing Act*, for the 2022 general local election, the following expense limits for candidates during the campaign period apply:

Mayor	\$16,324.49
Councillor	\$8,163.30
School Trustee	\$8,096.76

In accordance with the *Local Elections Campaign Financing Act*, for the 2022 general local election, the following third party advertising limits apply:

Directed advertising expense limit	\$816.22
Cumulative advertising expense limit	\$161,967.47
