ELECTOR REGISTRATION

Before you can vote in a Town of Comox election, you must be registered to vote. If you are not on the list of registered electors, you may register at the time of voting by completing the required application form available at the voting place.

To register to vote you must meet all of the following qualifications:

- 18 years of age or older on voting day;
- a Canadian citizen;
- a resident of BC for at least 6 months immediately preceding the day of registration;
- a resident of the Town of Comox on the day of registration OR a registered owner of real property in the Town of Comox for at least 30 days immediately before the day of registration;
- not disqualified under the Local Government Act or any other enactment from voting in an election or otherwise disqualified by law.

In addition, a non-resident property elector must not be entitled to register as a resident elector.

Resident electors will be required to produce 2 pieces of identification (at least one with a signature). Picture identification is not necessary. The two documents in combination must prove both identity and residency.

Non-resident property electors must produce 2 pieces of identification (at least one with a signature) to prove identity and must also produce proof of ownership in relation to the property in the way of a State of Title Certificate or a 2022 Property Tax Notice. Also note that:

- A person may only register as a non-resident property owner in relation to one parcel of real property in the Town of Comox.
- If more than one individual is a registered owner of the real property, then only one of those individuals is entitled to vote, with the written consent of a majority of registered owners that are on the title including the person requesting registration. A consent form is available at Town Hall if you wish to complete it in advance of voting day.
- If a corporation is on title with other individuals, or if an individual on title is holding the property in trust for a corporation or another trust, then none of the individuals are eligible to be registered as non-resident property electors.

NOTE: the combined BC Driver's Licence and CareCard count as 1 piece of ID only.

MAIL BALLOT VOTING

Mail ballot voting is available for ALL eligible Town of Comox Electors who are currently on the registered list of electors.

Requests for a mail ballot voting package can be made at Town Hall no later than 4:00 p.m. October 14, 2022, or at a voting location on voting days. Mail ballot voting packages can be requested by contacting Comox Town Hall at 250.339.2202.
