- Magazines, catalogues, yellow pages, white pages, and other directories (no books, please donate)
- Writing and home office paper, paper envelopes, notepads
- Paper gift wrap and greeting cards (musical greeting cards must go to a depot with e-waste)

PAPER PACKAGING AND CARDBOARD:

- Cardboard boxes (broken down and placed to fit inside the cart)
- Paper egg cartons
- Paper bags
- Clean cartons

PLASTIC: Single-use plastic items: Plastic disposable clothes

- Single-use plastic items: plates, bowls, cups, straws, cutlery, stir sticks, coffee/tea pods
- Plastic dental floss care and tape dispensers
- Plastic food storage containers

METAL:

- Thin gauge metal storage tins
- Food tins, cans and lids
- Aluminum foil wrap


