



Town of Comox – Summer Employment Opportunities 2026

The Town of Comox is seeking enthusiastic and responsible individuals to join our summer team at the Comox Community Centre and the Hands On Farm at Filberg Park. If you're passionate about creating memorable experiences for children and families, and enjoy working outdoors, this may be the perfect summer job for you!

Successful candidates will have experience working with children, strong communication and customer service skills, and current Emergency or Community First Aid/CPR C & AED certification. All staff must be able to submit a clear criminal record check. **Minimum age requirements:** Support Leaders must be at least 16 years old; all other positions require applicants to be 18 years or older. Applicants for Hands On Farm positions should also have experience and a passion for working with animals.

Summer Day Camp Positions

Summer Day Camp Leader – 2–3 positions

- Hours: 35–40 hours/week, Monday–Friday
- Dates: June 22 – September 4 (approx.)
- Wage: \$22/hour
- Working with children ages 3–11

Summer Day Camp Support Leader – 1–2 positions

- Hours: 35–40 hours/week, Monday–Friday
- Dates: June 22 – September 4 (approx.)
- Wage: \$19–20/hour
- Working with children ages 3–11
- Applicants must be at least 16 years old

Hands On Farm Positions

Hands On Farm Supervisor – 1 position

- Hours: 35–40 hours/week, Sunday–Thursday
- Dates: May 11 – August 23 (approx.)
- Wage: \$25/hour
- Working with children ages 5–12 and visitors of all ages
- Supervises seasonal farm staff and oversees day-to-day operations
- Coordinates group visits and external contractors
- Manages program budget and supply purchasing
- Oversees the Farm Club summer day camp
- Supports animal care routines and ensures visitor safety

Hands On Farm Attendant – 1 position

- Hours: 35–40 hours/week (consistent weekly schedule)
- Dates: May 25 – August 20 (approx.)
- Wage: \$22/hour
- Working with children ages 5–12 and visitors of all ages
- Applicants must be at least 16 years old

** All positions are non-union. Staff are eligible for the Employee Wellness Pass to the Comox Community Centre for the duration of their employment.
