Looking to make a difference in your community while working flexible hours? The Town of Comox is inviting applications for a **Casual Public Works Labourer** to support our Public Works crew. This is an on-call Union position (CUPE Local 556) with a rate of pay of \$29.77 per hour plus 12.8% in lieu of benefits including vacation and statutory holidays, sick leave and other paid leaves. The successful applicant will be required for vacation replacement and sick leave.

Working under the direction of the Public Works Foreperson and public works staff, the Casual Public Works Labourer assists with the construction, installation, inspection, and maintenance of the Town's public works infrastructure in support of the department's operational needs. The scope of work includes working in a team environment, the demonstration and willingness to learn, and the ability to perform all tasks in a safe manner.

Typical Duties & Responsibilities include assisting with:

- Waterworks construction, maintenance and repair tasks of the Town's water distribution system;
- Sewerage construction, maintenance and repair of operation of Town's sewage system including lift stations;
- Roadway and sidewalk maintenance and inspection;
- Installation and maintenance of drainage systems;
- Snow and ice control work;
- Hydrant grinding and painting; and,
- Other related duties as required.

Required Knowledge & Skills:

- Completion of Grade 12 or equivalency;
- Knowledge of WorkSafe BC rules and regulations;
- Ability to follow instructions and communicate with other staff and the public in a positive and courteous manner;
- Demonstrate the willingness to learn and keep informed of any operational and safety related requirements;
- Ability to safely perform the physical demands of the position, including lifting, carrying, bending, kneeling, walking on uneven terrain, and working outdoors in a variety of weather conditions;
- Valid Class 5 BC Driver's Licence with clean driving abstract; and,
- Current clean criminal record check.
